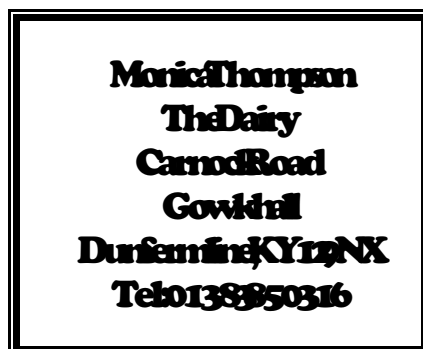

## RULES

1. **THE DECISION OF THE JUDGE IN EACH CLASS IS FINAL.**
2. **RIDDEN HORSES AND PONIES MUST BE AGED 4 YEARS OR OVER TO COMPETE.**
3. **COMPETITORS MUST BE CORRECTLY DRESSED BOTH WHEN COMPETING AND WHEN WALKING THE COURSES. A HAT COMPLYING WITH BRITISH STANDARDS RECOMMENDATIONS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.**
4. **TRAINERS MAY NOT BE WORN AT ANY TIME WHEN MOUNTED!**
5. **SHOWJUMPING CLASSES WILL BE HELD UNDER BRITISH SHOWJUMPING RULES WHERE APPLICABLE.**
6. **COMPETITORS MUST COME INTO THE RING MOUNTED AND CORRECTLY DRESSED FOR PRIZEGIVING.**
7. **COMPLAINTS MUST BE HANDED IN AT THE UNAFFILIATED HORSE SECTION SECRETARY'S CARAVAN IN WRITING, WITH A £20 DEPOSIT, IMMEDIATELY UPON CONCLUSION OF THE RELEVANT CLASS. THE DEPOSIT WILL BE RETURNED IF THE COMPLAINT IS UPHELD.**
8. **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.**
9. **THE COMMITTEE OF CENTRAL & WEST FIFE AGRICULTURAL SHOW UNAFFILIATED HORSE SECTION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRIES.**

## PONY CLUB PONY - Judge: Mr. Raymond Gatherum

**CLASS 5a PONY CLUB PONY 12.2 & Under including Lead Rein, riders not over 12 years.**

Competitors will be asked to walk, trot and canter and to jump 2 small fences.

**Note:** competitors entering lead rein section must be kept on a lead rein until end of class.

**CLASS 5b PONY CLUB PONY exceeding 12.2hh but not exceeding 13.2hh, riders not over 14 years.**

Competitors will be asked to walk, trot and canter and to jump 2 small fences.

**CLASS 5c PONY CLUB PONY exceeding 13.2hh but not exceeding 14.2hh, riders not over 16 years.**

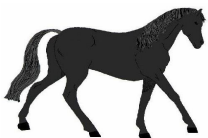

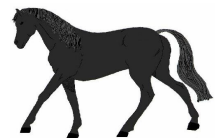

Note: PONIES COMPETING IN CLASS 7 MAY NOT ALSO COMPETE IN CLASS 10

- CLASS 6 LEAD REIN PONY – For ponies not exceeding 138cms and riders aged 12 and under.**  
Riders in this class cannot compete in any other jumping class except clear round. Height of jumps in the first round not to exceed 30cms.
- CLASS 7 NOVICE NOVICE PONY**  
Pony and rider combination not to have won more than two firsts in any showjumping competition. Height of jumps in first round not to exceed 60cms.
- CLASS 8 NOVICE PONY**  
Pony and rider combination not to have won more than three firsts in any show jumping competition. Height of jumps in first round not to exceed 75cms.
- CLASS 9 DOUBLE CLEAR CHALLENGE**  
Competitors jumping clear in the first round will complete the round again, immediately, against the clock as soon as the whistle blows. Height of jumps not to exceed 85cms.
- CLASS 10 SMALL OPEN PONY**  
Height of jumps in first round not to exceed 90cms.

NOTE: HORSES COMPETING IN CLASS 11 MAY NOT ALSO COMPETE IN CLASS 14

- CLASS 11 NOVICE NOVICE HORSE**  
Horse and rider combination not to have won more than two first places in any showjumping competition. Height of jumps in first round not to exceed 75cms.
- CLASS 12 NOVICE HORSE**  
Horse and rider combination not to have won more than three firsts in any show jumping competition. Height of jumps in first round not to exceed 85cms.
- CLASS 13 DOUBLE CLEAR CHALLENGE**  
Competitors jumping clear in the first round will complete the round again, immediately, against the clock as soon as the whistle blows. Height of jumps not to exceed 90cms.
- CLASS 14 SMALL OPEN HORSE**  
Height of jumps in first round approximately 1.00m.
